 What would you do if you saw something that made you feel sad, scared or worried?

"Tell a trusted adult straight away and they will delete it or help you get away from it"

"It is not your fault if you see it because it should not be on the internet to start with"

What do you know about strangers?

"They cannot be trusted"

"You mustn't ever talk to them"

"They might seem nice but it might be a trick"

"You are likely you see them on the street but also online. You wouldn't speak to a stranger on the street so you mustn't speak to them online either." • If you friends did not know about strangers, what would you tell them to keep them safe?

"If they talk to you then you must ignore them and go straight to your grown up."
