- What does the word safe mean?

*"It means the opposite to danger"*

*"You must not talk to strangers"*

*"To stay safe in school you must not run inside"*

- How do you keep yourself safe?

*"Stay with an adult near a road or cross the road alone"*

*"I never talk to strangers"*

*"I do not touch dangerous things"*

*"I stay safe on the internet by using a nick name instead of my real name"*

- How do you keep yourself safe when you are using the internet?

*"You should only go on the things that your mum and dad say are okay"*

*"Never send anything unkind in a message"*

*"Don't Face Time strangers"*

*"If you see something scary tell your parents"*

- What do you like doing the most on the internet?

*"Playing games"*

*"Playing GOGO Football"*

*"I like watching videos on You Tube about things I am interest in"*

*"I like 2Publish and Grannies Garden"*

- What sorts of things would make you feel sad, worried or scared if you saw them while you were using the internet?

*"People being unkind to animals- I once saw a picture of a puppy being hit by a car."*

*"Horrible messages would frighten me, like if someone said I will kill you!"*

*"A scary fire or a baby being hurt."*

*"People being mean."*

- What would you do if you saw something that made you feel sad, scared or worried?

*"Tell a trusted adult straight away and they will delete it or help you get away from it"*

*"It is not your fault if you see it because it should not be on the internet to start with"*

- What do you know about strangers?

*"They cannot be trusted"*

*"You mustn't ever talk to them"*

*"They might seem nice but it might be a trick"*

*"You are likely you see them on the street but also online. You wouldn't speak to a stranger on the street so you mustn't speak to them online either."*

- If your friends did not know about strangers, what would you tell them to keep them safe?

*"They are dangerous."*

*"You must never ever talk to them or go with them."*

*"Do not trust a stranger."*

*"If they talk to you then you must ignore them and go straight to your grown up."*
