Transferring to Junior School in September 2019

If your child is currently in Year 2 and due to transfer to junior school in September 2019, online applications are now open. You are encouraged to apply for a junior school place by logging on to www.westsussex.gov.uk/admissions.

The National closing date for transfer to junior school applications is Tuesday, 15th January 2019. It is your responsibility as a parent/carer to ensure your application is received by The Pupil Admission Team on time.

Starting School in September 2019

If your child's date of birth is between 1st September 2014 and 31st August 2015 it is now time to apply for their school place. Online applications are now open and you need to apply online by visiting www.westsussex.gov.uk/admissions.

The National closing date for starting school applications is Tuesday 15th January 2019.

Parent Consultations – November 2018



From 10.00am on Wednesday, 10th October you will be able to sign up for an appointment to meet with your child's class teacher on either Wednesday, 7th November, Monday, 12th November or Thursday, 15th November via the on-line booking system at www.trafalgarschool.parentseveningsystem.co.uk.

Parent Consultations take place in your child's classroom. If you are visiting a classroom in the main building, please come through the main door and go straight to the relevant room. If you are going to the huts, you do not need to come into the main building. If you can avoid bringing children on this occasion, you will probably find the meeting more beneficial. This is an important opportunity for you to have a one-to-one with the class teacher. We do hope you will be able to come.

If you do not have access to the internet, please contact the School Office on or after 10.00am on Wednesday, 10th October and they will be able to see which time slots are still available and will be happy to add appointments on your behalf.
