Mathematics

Number:

Counting numbers of objects/ actions/ sounds accurately.

Subitising (to 5) and using this knowledge when calculating in addition/ subtraction.

Recognising numbers to 20.

Finding one more and one less.

Automatically recalling some bonds to 10, including double facts.

Explore the composition of numbers to 10.

2D and 3D shape- select, rotate and manipulate shapes- recognise shapes within shapes.

Patterns- simple repeating patterns of two colours, numbers, shapes.
Extending to more complex patterns.
Comparing capacity.

Numerical Patterns:

Verbally counting beyond 20. Comparing quantities up to 10 in different contexts: greater then, less than/ the same as.

Explore and represent patterns in numbers up to 10, including evens and odds; doubles and halves.
